

WaveDriver 1.6 CS2 Update (Windows 98)

What's Fixed in WaverDriver 1.6 CS2

The Audiomedia III WaveDriver version 1.6 (included with the Pro Tools LE 5.0.1 release) causes some Audiomedia III cards to “crackle” during playback. This problem has been fixed in the 1.6 CS2 version of the WaveDriver.

Updating the Audiomedia III Wave Driver

To use this fix, you'll need to update your existing 1.6 WaveDriver.

To update the Audiomedia III WaveDriver:

- 1** From the desktop, right-click My Computer and choose Properties.
- 2** In the System Control Panel, click the Device Manager tab.
- 3** In the list of devices in “Sound, video & game controllers,” double-click the Audiomedia III.
- 4** Click the Driver tab, then click Update Driver.
- 5** When the Update Device Driver Wizard opens, click Next.
- 6** Select the option for “Display a list of all the drivers in a specific location,” then click Next.
- 7** Click Have Disk.
- 8** In the Install From Disk dialog, click Browse. Navigate to the volume and folder containing the new WaveDriver files (previously downloaded and unzipped) and click OK.
- 9** In the Select Device dialog, make sure the Audiomedia III is selected and click OK.
- 10** Click OK to close the Install From Disk dialog.
- 11** Click Next to update the driver.
- 12** Once Windows has finished updating the driver, click Finish.
